## Greetings from the Pro Shop

The end of the 2011 golf season is rapidly approaching. The leaves are turning, the acorns and walnuts are falling, the colors are beautiful, and November has arrived. The golf course is in wonderful shape, the greens have recovered from the September aeration, and the fairways are in immaculate condition, the best I have seen them in the 40 plus years I have played at Willow Bend.

Due to the frequency of frost, the new Pro Shop hours for November will be 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekends. The Pro Shop will be closed on Mondays. If the afternoon highs are 45 degrees or below, or we have inclement weather (rain or sleet) the Pro Shop will remain closed. Under normal conditions we are open the first few weeks of November until the pins are removed and the course is closed for the season.

Members who have won or purchased a gift certificate need to redeem them as soon as possible. They are set to expire November 1st, 2011 but can be extended through November 8th.
